Förväntade studieresultat

The objective of the course is to provide the students with an international perspective on digital journalism.

Innehåll

This course is given in collaboration with other European universities. The object is to analyse indicators of digital journalism and ways to measure quality criteria. The students use digital technology and Internet to discuss online journalistic quality. Students work in international groups and analyse European journalistic sites based on the concepts of interactivity, content and usability.

Undervisningsformer

The course uses a special methodology developed for the course by the University of Kalmar, Pompeu Fabra University in Barcelona, Spain, and Windesheim School voor Journalistiek in Zwolle, Holland. It includes lectures and seminars at each of the universities involved, international video conferences and Internet discussions. Interactivity among the participating students is essential.

Examinationsformer

Kursen bedöms med betygen Underkänd, Godkänd eller Väl godkänd.

Examination through participation in lectures, group activities in Kalmar and virtually with the students in Barcelona and Zwolle.

Students in Kalmar also write and present a paper to be discussed in seminars.

The evaluation results are compiled in a course report, which is recorded with the department administrator and entered in the next program council meeting.
