Expected learning outcomes

After completing the course, the student should be able to:

- present prehistoric cultural conditions in Scandinavia in general and in Östergötland in particular from an archaeological perspective,
- demonstrate elementary knowledge about previous archaeological research and ongoing projects in Östergötland concerning its prehistory and early history.

Content

The course offers a general scientific introduction to Scandinavian prehistory and early history with special emphasis on the extensive amount of research conducted in Östergötland in the last decade, with particular focus on prehistory and the Middle Ages.

Type of Instruction

Teaching may be in the form of separate lectures and a voluntary excursion.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).
