Objectives

After completing the course, the student should be able to:

- apply strategies for working with graphic elements,
- process and present material in a multi-page layout in an appropriate way,
- conduct basic editing of digital images, and create basic image montage,
- describe principles for the construction of digital images,
- · use basic tools for vector graphics.

Content

This course focuses on layout, basic image editing, the preparation of illustrations/vector graphics, and digital image and colour theory.

Attendance in lectures, laboratory sessions and presentations is compulsory unless otherwise indicated.

Type of Instruction

Teaching is delivered in the form of lectures, supervision, exercises/laboratory sessions and assignments.

The structure of the course means that the student must work in accordance with guidelines and time frames communicated when the course starts.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the student must achieve the objectives. This means that the student must receive the grade of Pass in all assignments, seminars and examinations. The course is examined through assignments, seminars and a written examination. Grading criteria for the grade of Pass with Distinction will be specified when the course starts.

Assessment is based on the following dimensions: theory, craftsmanship/method and visualisation.

For students who do not pass the first examinations, retake examinations are provided in accordance with local regulations at the university.

Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted. Results and analysis of the course evaluation are communicated to the students who have taken the course and the students who are taking the course when it is offered the next time. The evaluation is anonymous. The course evaluation is filed according to departmental regulations.
