Prerequisites

Having successfully completed the courses Interior Design I (1DI043), Retail Communication I (1DI044) and Retail Communication II (1DI047), or equivalent.

Objectives

After completing this course, students will be able to:

- suggest possible solutions for an interior decoration assignment, regarding the assignment as a whole as well as its various components
- problematize the assignment, and apply artistic methods during the project work, based on the acquired theoretical and practical knowledge
- carry out practical assignments and select the appropriate means for their visualization.

Content

Analytical studies are combined with applied studies associated to the theme of "Home". Studies around the concept of home, target group analysis and practical studies of interior decoration of the home environment.

Type of Instruction

Lectures, experiments (workshops), tutoring, seminars, study tours, self-study and

projects. During a project, independent work is combined with lectures, laboratory work, study tours, individual tuition and seminars (part and final presentations).

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The examination forms comprise submitted assignments. Practical and theoretical knowledge building requires active participation in all course elements, with a minimum attendance of 80%.

Course Evaluation

A written course evaluation will be carried out at the end of the course, in accordance with the guidelines of the university. The course evaluation will be filed in the archives of the department.
