Objectives

Knowledge and understanding

The student shall be able to:

• have basic knowledge of artistic methods and techniques for drawing applicable to design work.

Skills and ability

The student shall be able to:

 have developed artistic skills and apply artistic methods and techniques for drawing in design work.

Ability to judge and value

The student shall be able to:

• individually relate artistic methods and techniques for drawing in practical design work.

Content

The course gives basic artistic training with different methods and techniques for drawing that develop the visual thinking.

The course comprises drawing for configuration and visual presentation of products through sketch, figure drawing and perspective.

Type of Instruction

Lectures, laboratory and practical work (workshops), tutoring and self-study.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F.

The examination includes assignments to be submitted.

The course is assessed with the grades A, B, C, D, E, or F. The grade A constitutes the highest grade on the scale and the remaining grades follow in descending order where the grade E is the lowest grade on the scale that will result in a pass. The grade F means that the student's performance is assessed as fail.

Course Evaluation
