Objectives

After completing this course the student should be able to:

- explain and correctly use basic accounting concepts and relationships
- explain the fundamentals of management accounting

- describe basic principles and methods in budgeting
- prepare budgets in given situations
- enter basic transactions into double bookkeeping system
- explain the basics of business ratio analysis
- prepare simple financial statements using accruals

Content

The course contains:

- basic concepts and links in business administration
- objectives and functions of management accounting
- performance planning
- foundations of budgeting and the budgeting process
- introduction to current record of accounting and year-end closing
- introduction to business ratio analysis

Type of Instruction

The teaching consists of lectures and seminars.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades A, B, C, D, E or F.

The course is examined through an individual written examination 6.5 credits and a written computer lab with associated oral seminar 1 credit. The computer lab is done in groups.

The written exam consists of two parts; the first part consists of basic issues and the second part consists of more developed issues. The first part must be approved for the second part to be assessed. Both parts must be completed with a minimum passing grade during the same examination offering in order for the exam as a whole to be graded with the minimum passing grade. The grade will be based on the total sum result from part 1 and 2.

The grade A constitutes the highest grade on the scale and the remaining grades follow in descending order where the grade E is the lowest grade on the scale that will result in a pass. The grade F means that the student's performance is assessed as fail.

Resit examination is offered in accordance with Linnaeus University's Local regulations for courses and examination at the first- and second-cycle levels.

In the event that a student with a disability is entitled to special study support, the examiner will decide on adapted or alternative examination arrangements.

Course Evaluation

A course evaluation should be conducted during the course or in connection with its conclusion. The results and analysis of the completed course evaluation should be promptly communicated to students who have completed the course. Students participating in the next course instance should be informed of the results of the previous course evaluation and any improvements that have been made, no later than at the start of the course.
