Prerequisites

At least 22.5 credits from History, general course, 30 credits, or the equivalent.

Objectives

After completing the course, the students should be able to:

- account for and discuss teaching of history, focusing on knowledge and assessment,
- discuss assessment on the basis of concrete examples and current policy documents,
- analyse how a chosen historical time period is covered in textbooks and other teaching material,
- identify and analyse pupils' and teachers' meetings with and conceptions of knowledge of history,
- identify and analyse the use of history and discuss this in relation to the teaching of history.

Content

This is a didactic course focusing on knowledge, the use of history and assessment. On the basis of experiences from field studies, the relation between pupils' and teachers' conceptions of history and policy documents for the teaching of history is discussed. Examples of the use of history and how these can be used in the teaching of history are studied and discussed. Grades and assessments are discussed on the basis of current policy documents. Concrete examples of pupils' test answers are analysed and discussed in relation to the intended learning outcomes. The students also practise

Seminars are compulsory.

Type of Instruction

Teaching is delivered in the form of lectures, group exercises and seminars.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course is examined through written assignments and active participation in seminars.

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the intended learning outcomes must be achieved. Grading criteria for the grade of Pass with Distinction (VG) can be found in a study guide.

For students who do not pass the first examinations, retake examinations are provided in accordance with local regulations at the university.

Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted and compiled into a report, which is made available to students. The report is archived by the department responsible for the course.
