Prerequisites

General entry requirements.

Expected learning outcomes

The aim of the course is to lay a foundation for awareness, understanding and knowledge of the ways in which sport and health activities can be organised in Swedish society. In that connection, governmental and municipal organisation and the sports movement's personal non-profit organisation are dealt with.

On completion of the course, students should

- have acquired basic knowledge the social organisation of sport
- have acquired knowledge of how Swedish Sports Confederation affiliated sports are organised
- have acquired basic knowledge of the economisation and globalisation of sport

Content

The course contains the following elements:

- the organisation of politics
- sport and municipal politics
- the organisation of sport

- Swedish sport politics
- sport as a branch
- globalisation of sport

Type of Instruction

Teaching is in the form of lectures, literary studies, group work, supervision and seminars. Attendance at lessons is obligatory unless otherwise agreed upon with the examiner.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

Course Evaluation

Course evaluations are carried out verbally and/or in writing continuously throughout the course. At the end of the course, a written course evaluation is performed. Course evaluations are compiled and stored at the institution. The results are fed back to the students who have taken the course and are presented, together with the possible measures taken, to the students the next time the course is given.
