Prerequisites

General entry requirements. Specific entry requirements: Coach education through a Special Sports Federation, or the equivalent.

Objectives

After completing the course, students shall be able to:

- describe and apply various social scientific perspectives on coaching and talent development
- critically evaluate the role of the coach in the talent development process, based on scientific perspectives
- describe, explain and analyse various activities within the field of talent development.

Content

On the basis of social sciences, the course discusses talent development and the role of the coach in the talent development process. The course also contains a theoretical specialisation related to analysis, development and improvement of a sports activity.

Type of Instruction

Teaching consists of lectures, films, supervision and participation in discussions together with fellow students.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U) or Pass (G).

Examination of the course takes place by means of two written assignments. In order to receive a grade of Pass in the course, both examination assignments must be assessed

as Pass.

Course Evaluation

A course evaluation is carried out either during or at the end of the course. Results and analysis of the evaluation are presented to the students who have completed the course, as well as to new students at the following course date. The course evaluation is conducted anonymously.
