Expected learning outcomes

Students should, via the carrying out of concrete information/ assignments/projects in working like, develop their ability to work, mission-based, from idea to reality.

On completion of the course, students should be able to

- demonstrate the ability to plan, carry out and critically examine assignments of a project nature
- reflect over the complexities and importance of leadership in a mission-based organisation
- reflect over the meaning of relations and network in a mission-based organisation
- demonstrate the ability to independently take responsibility for and, under supervision, carry out activities of a mission nature

Content

- financing of missions
- administration of missions

Type of Instruction

Teaching is in the form of practice through missions within various organisations as well as seminars, where practical experiences are discussed from relevant literature

Examination

Course evaluations are carried out verbally and/or in writing continuously throughout the course. At the end of the course, a written course evaluation is performed. Course evaluations are compiled and stored at the institution. The results are fed back to the students who have taken the course and are presented, together with the possible measures taken, to the students the next time the course is given.
