Objectives

The purpose of UBL is that students will transform and strengthen their theoretical knowledge into practice by demonstrating expertise in implementing specific tasks/assignments/projects at work. The aim is also to analyze and reflect on the completed assignment.

After completing the course, students should be able to

- under supervision plan and organize for the training relevant missions
- autonomously execute and document the education relevant missions
- write and orally summarize and describe the relevant training mission
- analyze and critically evaluate completed assignments in relation to their roles and leadership complexity and importance of the mission

Content

The course contains the following elements:

- plan and organize tasks in practice
- undertake missions in practice
- evaluate assignments both in theory and practice

Type of Instruction

Teaching consists of practice through assignments in different organizations as well as supervision, where the assignment is discussed regularly and where practical experience is discussed from the relevant literature.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

Course Evaluation

Course evaluations are carried out and are compiled in writing and fed back to the students. The compilation is presented to relevant institutional bodies and the programme council. The compilation is filed at the responsible institution.

Other

Possible additional fees regarding assignments and such shall be paid by the student.

Required Reading and Additional Study Material

The literature is retrieved from the previous courses taken before in the Coaching and Sport Management program. As the tasks are different, the student should use relevant literature for the mission.
