Objectives

After completing the module, the student should be able to:

- use their own theoretical and practical knowledge of journalism at a journalism workplace,
- describe and evaluate their own performance as well as the editorial environment,
- reflect critically and independently on the journalism profession.

Content

This course consists of an individual internship in an editorial environment, in which the student conducts journalistic work such as research, interviews, production of text/images, editing, etc.

Type of Instruction

The student is responsible for finding an internship to be approved by the person responsible for the course. Some help may be provided by the department. Teaching is delivered in the form of supervision at the work place and through contact with a supervisor at the department.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course is examined through an internship, a written internship report and seminars.

In order to receive the grade of pass, the student must achieve the course objectives. For students who do not pass the first examinations, retake examinations are provided in accordance with local regulations at the university.

Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted and compiled in accordance with regulations at Linnaeus University. Results and analysis of the course evaluation are communicated to the students who have taken the course and the students who are taking the course when it is offered the next time. The evaluation is anonymous. The course evaluation is filed according to departmental regulations.
