### Objectives

On completion of the course, students should be able to:

- demonstrate basic proficiency in project management and project guidance,
- independently plan, carry out, follow-up and present a project within the field of cultural heritage,
- demonstrate and utilize basic knowledge of economical planning that is related to carrying out a project.

### Content

Within a given timeframe, students must plan a project that is connected to the field of cultural heritage. The project work includes preparation, the carrying out and touching-up, as well as presentation of results. Special attention is given to a clear content and schedule as well as a basic economical calculation for the project.

All education, except for lectures, is mandatory.

### Type of Instruction

Teaching is in the form of lectures, seminars, workshops and excursions.

### Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the student must achieve the objectives. Grading criteria for the grade of Pass with Distinction will be specified when the course starts.

Examination occurs through presentation of a project.

For students who do not pass the first examinations, retake examinations are provided in accordance with local regulations at the university.

### Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted. Results and analysis of the course evaluation are communicated to the students who have taken the course and the students who are taking the course when it is offered the next time. The evaluation is anonymous. The course evaluation is filed according to departmental regulations.
