### **Prerequisites**

## Objectives

After completing the course, the student should be able to:

- account in general terms for basic parts of the history of children's literature,
- describe and explain theories, terminology and methods used in children's literature research,
- interpret and discuss children's literature.

## Content

This course includes an introduction to children's and adolescents' literature and its history, focusing on the 20th century and the present. Models for literary analysis and literary terminology – especially terminology used in the field of children's literature – are introduced. The module also includes close readings of a number of texts.

## Type of Instruction

The teaching consists of lectures, assignments and group discussions.

## Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the student must demonstrate active participation on the online learning platform and achieve the objectives. Grading criteria for the grade of Pass with Distinction will be specified when the course starts.

The course is examined through individual written assignments and group discussions.

Repeat examination is offered in accordance with Local regulations for courses and examination at the first and second-cycle level at Linnaeus University. If the university has decided that a student is entitled to special pedagogical support due to a disability, the examiner has the right to give a customised exam or to have the student conduct the exam in an alternative way.

## Course Evaluation

During the implementation of the course or in close conjunction with the course, a course evaluation is to be carried out. Results and analysis of the course evaluation are to be promptly presented as feedback to the students who have completed the course. Students who participate during the next course instance receive feedback at the start of the course. The course evaluation is to be carried out anonymously.
