### **Prerequisites**

At least 105 credits in journalism or media production.

# **Objectives**

After completing the course, the students should be able to:

- apply academic knowledge in media production through an individual internship at a workplace relevant to the subject,
- critically reflect on and discuss the conditions and professional roles of the media industry,
- critically reflect on and discuss creative and technical processes, methods and tools experienced during the internship,
- critically reflect on and discuss their own and others' performance and internship experiences.

#### Content

This course includes an internship in media production, during which the student applies knowledge and skills acquired in previous subject studies. The course also includes critical academic reflection in the form of a report and seminars.

All parts in which the course objectives are examined are compulsory.

# Type of Instruction

The student is responsible for finding an internship to be approved by the person responsible for the course. Some help may be provided by the department.

Teaching is delivered in the form of supervision at the work place and through contact with a supervisor at the department.

# Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course is examined through an internship, a written report and seminars. In order to receive the grade of pass, the student must achieve the course objectives.

The grading criteria are available in a document communicated to the students when the course starts.

## Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted in line with regulations at Linnaeus University. The results are compiled into a report, which is filed and stored and made available to students according to departmental regulations.

### Other

To be admitted to the course, the student must have received the grade of Pass on at least 105 credits in the first and second years of the Journalism and Media Production Programme.
