Expected learning outcomes

After completed course the student is expected to be able to:

- understand and discuss current issues of Gender and Women in the Global South
- understand and discuss theories and apply these to the topics
- conduct an independent and analytical research paper on one important - current or future - issue of Gender and Women in the Global South.

Content

In the course current issues about gender and women will be discussed and analyzed in the Global South. Special attention will be given to Latin America.

Type of Instruction

The teaching methods consist of lectures, seminars and/or other assignments. The course is taught in English. At some moments of the course, attendance is required.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course is assessed by a written and/or oral exam, which may be accompanied by a seminar session. The grades are transferred to the following ECTS grades: A, B, C, D, E, F or Fx.

Course Evaluation

A written evaluation is completed after the course, and it will be archived at the School of Social Sciences. The result and possible changes will be communicated to the students next time the course will be given.
