**Prerequisites**

Swedish as a foreign language, 1–7.5 credits.

### Objectives

After completing the course, the students should be able to:

- communicate in everyday conversations in Swedish,
- read and retell textbooks and basic articles in Swedish.

### Content

The course includes studies of Swedish language structures of increasing degrees of difficulty. The main focus is on learning basic spoken and written Swedish.

### Type of Instruction

Teaching is delivered in the form of lectures and exercises in speaking, listening and writing, individually and in groups.

### Examination

The course is assessed with the grades A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F.

The course is examined through a written examination and oral presentations.

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the student must achieve the objectives. The grade of A is the highest grade and the grade of E is the lowest grade for passing the course. The grade of F means that the student has failed the course. The grading criteria are available in a document communicated to the students when the course starts.

## Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted. Results and analysis of the course evaluation are communicated to the students who have taken the course and the students who are taking the course when it is offered the next time.

The evaluation is anonymous. The course evaluation is filed according to departmental regulations.

This course cannot be part of a degree in combination with another course in which the content fully or partly correspond to the content of this course: The course overlaps with 1SV741 at Linnaeus University.
