Prerequisites

Swedish as a foreign language, 1-30 credits.

Objectives

After completing the course, the students should be able to:

- apply oral and written Swedish language skills in various situations,
- demonstrate knowledge of basic Swedish words and expressions related to studying and working,
- explain and account for various aspects of Swedish society and culture.

Content

The students develop their knowledge through extensive reading and writing exercises in different genres, such as reviews, instructions and reports. The students also develop their oral language proficiency so that they can express themselves clearly and well-structured regarding complex facts. By studying various texts on, for example, Swedish society, the students develop their vocabulary and ability to express themselves.

Type of Instruction

Teaching is delivered in the form of lectures and exercises in speaking, listening and writing, individually and in groups.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades A, B, C, D, E, Fx or F.

The course is examined through a written examination and oral presentations.

In order to receive the grade of pass, the student must achieve the course objectives. The grade of A is the highest grade and the grade of E is the lowest grade for passing the course. The grade of F means that the student has failed the course. The grading criteria are available in a document communicated to the students when the course starts.

Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted and compiled into a report, which is made available to students and filed and stored according to departmental regulations.
