Admission is granted to students within the exchange study programme at the university who have completed 15 credits in Beginners' Swedish or the equivalent.

Expected learning outcomes

After completing the course the students should be able to

- speak fluently in basic Swedish
- use grammatically acceptable basic Swedish
- express ideas and thoughts in writing by using vocabulary within the course level.

Content

Vocabulary language structures are studied. The emphasis is on practical, spoken and written Swedish.

Type of Instruction

Teaching methods consist of lectures and exercises, both individually and in groups.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

In addition, ECTS-grades are awarded.

Assessment methods consist of oral and written tests and assignments.

Course Evaluation

When the course has finished, an evaluation is compiled. The results are reported to the students and then archived according to the rules of the school.
