Prerequisites

General entry requirements and German as a third (foreign) language, course B/stage 3 (field-specific entry requirements 2 with the exception of English B).

Objectives

After completing the course, the students should be able to:

- hold conversations, argue and give short presentations in German,
- account for the history, functions and goals of the European Union, using relevant terminology.

Content

This module includes reading prose and newspaper texts. The module also includes an introduction to the history and organisation of the European Union. Relevant issues and intercultural communication are discussed.

Type of Instruction

Teaching is delivered in the form of lectures and seminars in which the students' oral presentations are discussed. Attendance is compulsory.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course is examined through oral and written presentations.

In order to receive the grade of Pass, the student must achieve the intended learning

outcomes.

Course Evaluation

At the end of the course, a course evaluation is conducted and compiled into a report, which is made available to students and filed according to departmental regulations.
