Prerequisites

Successfully completed courses in Social work 60 credits and 15 credits in law.

Objectives

After completing the course, students shall be able to:

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of evaluation and systematic follow-up in social work
- Describe the importance of evidence-based practice in social work and reflect upon this
- Critically review evaluation reports
- Apply basic knowledge of quantitative methods when constructing a questionnaire and processing data in SPSS
- Construct an evaluation of an organisation or an intervention in social work

Content

- Relations between follow-up, evaluation and research
- Evaluation models
- Evaluation as an integrated aspect in the practice of social work
- Evidence-based practice in social work
- Review of evaluations carried out in social organisations
- Formulation of a questionnaire and processing data in SPSS

Type of Instruction

Teaching is based on a problem-oriented method and includes lectures, seminars, group discussions, practical exercises and field studies. Compulsory attendance will be required for parts of the course, which is stipulated in the course study guidelines.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

Examination takes place by means of an oral examination, a written examination and a practical session.

A retake of the examination is offered within six weeks after the initial examination date (within the scope of the regular semester). In order to receive a grade of Pass, the student must have acquired basic knowledge of social work equivalent to the intended learning outcomes of the course.

The criteria for the grade Pass with Distinction are stipulated in the study guidelines.

Course Evaluation

A course evaluation will be conducted at the end of the course. The evaluation follows the department's web-based course evaluation template. The course evaluation will be collated and returned to the students by the course coordinator. The collated evaluation will be filed in accordance with the departmental regulations.
