Prerequisites

Basic eligibility and 60 hp courses within total quality maintenance, or the equivalent.

Expected learning outcomes

In-depth knowledge within a delimited area covered by total quality maintenance.

Content

The course is an independent, in-depth study within total quality maintenance. The study could be in form of a literature study or a combination of theoretical and empirical material. The work should be within a well-defined area covered by total quality maintenance, and lead to in-depth knowledge within this area. Selection of area and aim is made in consultation with the examiner.

Type of Instruction

The teaching consists of tutoring.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades U,3,4 or 5.

Examination is made on the report and an oral presentation of the findings.

Course Evaluation

A written course evaluation will be carried out at the end of the course in accordance with the guidelines of the University. The course evaluation will be filed at the department.
