## Expected learning outcomes

After completing the course the students are expected to have widened their knowledge and understanding of

- labour laws
- conflicts and handling of conflicts
- individual and group behaviour
- group functions in specific teams in the industry
- different types and philosophies of leadership
- psychological and personality assessment tests
- effective and industry-specific communication

Additionally, students are expected to apply above named leadership areas on forest and wood related working areas, i.e. the gained knowledge on leadership should directly be related to relevant working situations.

## Content

- labour law
- communication, conflicts and handling of conflicts
- individual and group behaviour
- leadership styles and -philosophies
- assessment tests in human resource planning

## Type of Instruction

The course is offered as a distance course by means of IKT, internet and meetings. The meetings can contain lectures, guest lectures, exercises, excursions and seminars.

## Examination

The course is assessed with the grades U,3,4 or 5.
