# Expected learning outcomes

On completion of the course, students should be able to:

- Analyse the complexity in the specialist nurse's function and responsibility in community based psychiatric care
- With support in caring science, independently suggest and motivate ideas regarding health-promotional efforts in community based psychiatric care
- Analyse the connection between mental disabilities and cultural aspects, such as

- ethnic and social belonging
- Problematize and analyse the meaning of stigmatization as well as suggest and motivate how different efforts can influence stigmatization

- Community based psychiatric care
- Function and responsibility of the specialist nurse with specialization in psychiatric care
- Health-promotional efforts
- Cultural aspects concerning functional disabilities
- Stigmatization

The web-based learning platform forms a tuition base.

### Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

In order to receive a grade of pass, all expected learning outcomes mush be achieved. The course is examined through written examinations. A resit examination is offered in accordance with local rules for examination on entry level and advanced level at Linnaeus University (Dnr:HL/2010-3069). Students at Linnaeus University can, at request, receive their grades in ECTS credits, according to the ECTS-scale. This request should be made at the introduction of the course.

### Course Evaluation

A written evaluation is carried out and compiled in a report, which is archived at the institution. The results, along with possible measures taken, are reported to the students the next time the course is given.
