## Objectives

The course focuses on literature relevant to theory and empirical data and the project that the student is to carry out.

The student shall be able to:

- describe and summarize the current state of research in a specific field,
- evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of various theoretical perspectives,
- outline the methodological implications of specific theoretical choices.

## Content

The course involves individual study of literature to be presented in the form of a paper as well as orally at a seminar.

## Type of Instruction

Independent studies and supervision.

## Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course consists of individual study of literature to be examined by means of a paper and an oral presentation of the project at a seminar.
