### **Prerequisites**

Degree of Bachelor of Arts in Sociology, or the equivalent.

## Objectives

The course is focused on relevant theory and empirical data in relation to the course literature for the degree project, and is adapted to the student's individual project.

Students shall be able to:

- account for and summarize the current state of research within their specific fields
- form an opinion about the pros and cons of different theoretical perspectives
- account for the methodological consequences of the theoretical choices.

## Content

The course includes individual study of literature to be presented in the form of a paper as well as orally at a seminar.

## Type of Instruction

Self-study and supervision.

## Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

The course consists of individual study of literature to be examined by means of a paper and an oral presentation of the project at a seminar.

### **Course Evaluation**

A course evaluation is carried out at the end of the course. The results of the evaluation are compiled and presented to the students, and filed in accordance with the departmental regulations.

### **Required Reading and Additional Study Material**

The course literature is chosen in consultation with the course coordinator.
