Content

The course involves individual study of literature to be presented in the form of a paper as well as orally at a seminar.

Type of Instruction

Independent studies and supervision.

Examination

The course is assessed with the grades Fail (U), Pass (G) or Pass with Distinction (VG).

A written project and oral presentation at a seminar.
